

Boardwalk Repair Instructions

Boardwalk Locations/Names



Tools Needed

- Safety Glasses
- Hammer
- Pry Bar and/or Crow Bar (optional, but, helpful when prying off existing rotted boards)
- Chisel (Optional)
- Boards and Nails will be supplied



Additional, If holes are not pre-drilled

- 1/8 (one eighths) bit
- Drill
- Square or Speed Square
- Measuring Tapes

Pre-Drilling Holes on Boards

If you are volunteering to replace boards on 9/19/20-9/20/20, the boards for the Lily Pond Boardwalk are already pre-drilled. You will need to drill holes or just nail without on the Finger Marsh Boardwalk on all short boards. The Long board for this boardwalk has been pre-drilled.

****Important**** Please make sure that you take boards from the right stack of boards. The amount of boards needed and the nail hole parameters for each site (Lily Pond) and (Finger Marsh/Waldorf) are different and will not align for hammering unless you have the right boards for the right location.

Lily Pond Boardwalk

Boards are in the Right Pile as you face our driveway at 17 Spencer Street

Finger Marsh Boardwalk

Boards are in the Left Pile.

Nails: You will need 4 nails for every short board and 6 nails for each long board
